



Passages provides Perth's marginalised and homeless young people with a "passage" to help them to transition from one life to another. Young people are supported to get off the streets and adopt safer and healthier lifestyles.

Passages' primary function is to act as a referral centre from its property at 22 Palmerston Street Northbridge in Western Australia. However, it also offers a range of other services to young people with a lived experience of homelessness, such as:

- Food vouchers, Smart Rider's and Phone Cards
- Education and training support
- Bathroom, kitchen and laundry facilities
- Computer and Internet access
- Mail collection
- Workshops and activities
- Key support services
- Information, advocacy, advice and referrals
- Use of Outcomes Star Tool
